

PARENT/GUARDIAN GUIDELINES FOR TEEN SEA CAMP DIVETECH @ COBALT COAST RESORT – GRAND CAYMAN

Welcome to Teen Sea Camp with Divetech @ Cobalt Coast Resort (Grand Cayman). We have found that the family that dives together has the best time together! To make this a more enjoyable time for yourselves and your children, we do ask that you abide by the following guidelines. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask at any time.

1. You will be running 2 separate tabs for incidental charges not included in your Teen Sea Camp package – one with the hotel and one with the dive shop. Please settle both tabs at the end of the week. Please advise your children and their instructors IF they are **allowed to charge** snacks, drinks etc to the room or dive shop during the week to avoid surprises at the end of your stay. Refreshments including cool aid, soft drink/juice with lunch and ice water with daily snacks are provided in your package already. Examples....
 - Charging at Cobalt Coast: Drinks such as smoothies can be ordered from the bar at lunch if desired. Your child's name and a room number must be provided to the bartender to do this.
 - Charging at Divetech: Sodas, Juices, PowerAde, chips and candy are available at the dive shop and can be charged to your waivers there. We will need your child's last name to accomplish this.
2. **Camp runs daily from 8am until 3pm.** It is very important that children are dropped off and picked up in a timely manner to accomplish all the activities we have planned for the week.
 - Drop –offs: Please ensure that your child has a pair of shoes, their dive/snorkel equipment, sun block, hat, t-shirt, a room key if they will need access to it at any point and their course materials. Room keys can be left in the Dive shop if needed. They will receive Camp tote bags and these should be brought as well to keep everything organized.
 - Pick-ups: It is very important that you are in the designated area to have your children released to you at 3pm daily. After camp babysitting services are available if you wish time away or a night out. Please inquire at Cobalt Coast office if you would like more information. Staff will not release your children until you come to pick them up. Arrangements can be made to have your child released to another adult or parent as long as this is discussed with both the counselor and the child so that everyone knows what is going on. No children should be unattended at any time.

EXCEPTIONS:

- Friday: Camp will end when the Stingray City trip is over.
 - The Jr. Open Water class will run 8am – 5pm Sunday, Monday & Tuesday.
3. **No children may be left alone** or unattended at the pool at any time. There is no lifeguard at the pool, so once camp is over, your children must be supervised at all times please. **CHILDREN MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN THE POOL. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY AFTER CAMP HOURS.**

4. Please label your children's mask, fins, wetsuits, bags and the like so that they can be returned to their proper owner if lost. Paint pens are available at the diveshop.
5. If there are any special needs with regard to **medication, diet** or otherwise please talk one on one to their instructors ahead of time to ensure that we can provide the best supervision possible.
6. There are sign up sheets for the **Boatswain's Beach/Cayman Turtle Farm**. So that we can arrange for tickets and transportation, we request that you please sign up by Sunday afternoon for this excursions. This is included in the Teens program and the Non-Diver program. Sign-up includes transportation.
7. Please sign up by Sunday for the Tuesday night **guided shore night dive**. That way we can have the appropriate number of staff, tanks, lights organized. This is included in all adult diver packages. You are also welcome to shore dive as a buddy team any nights with our complimentary shore diving inclusion in your package. The shore reefs are wonderful at night – this is the best experience available!! Your children will be looked after at the Critter Slide Show on Tuesday night.
8. Tanks on the boats are 80cuft air tanks. If you would like nitrox or smaller tanks (63cuft), please advise the dive shop in advance and we will have your requested tanks available for you. **Nitrox** tanks are \$12.; 100cuft Nitrox tanks are \$18. and 100cuft air tanks are \$15. each.
9. **Let us know how we are doing!!** If there are any concerns, needs compliments or complaints PLEASE let us know immediately so that we can correct any mistakes or fix any problems. We are here to make sure you and your family has a great time and if there is anything we can do to improve upon our services we are happy to work with you to do this.
